The Year 6 Mini-Fete will be held on **Wednesday 11th December 2019**, in the Cola and Oval area. The fete will be commencing at 1:20pm and finishing up at 2:45pm.

The children are invited to wear **mufti clothes** on this day and are encouraged to give a **gold coin donation** to support this fundraising event. The money raised will be used to purchase the Year 6 gift. It promises to be a fun afternoon for all!

The Year 6 students and teachers have been busy organising activities and purchasing goods for the day. Year 6 students have also been creating their own original products and activities, which they will be running and selling to students at the mini-fete.

Costing of activities: Students will need to purchase a **PRE-PAID CARD (at the front office)** if they wish to participate in the mini-fete activities. **Pre-paid cards will be held at the office and handed to the students on the day.**

Each card will be worth a certain amount of stamps and when students visit a store their card will be stamped. There are **THREE** cards available for purchase (of different value) that students can choose from:

CARD 1: \$2.00 = 4 stamps

CARD 2: \$5.00 = 10 stamps

CARD 3: \$10.00 = 20 stamps
